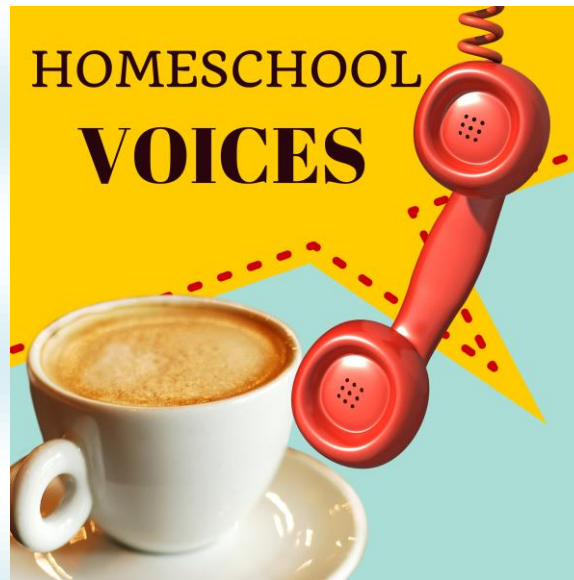


HOMESCHOOL VOICES PODCAST
